We are a **network** of young people and youth workers with a need to live in a sustainable way with ourselves, our local communities and nature, both in cities and rural areas. We bring young people close to ecovillages and other sustainable initiatives through Erasmus+ Youth projects.

We are connected to different National Networks of Ecovillages in Europe and with **Next-GEN Europe**, the youth wing of the Global Ecovillage Network Europe (GEN Europe). Also, we are linked to **GEN Europe** and have representation in their Projects Working Group.

OUR VISION

"A world in which young people are empowered to create resilient communities, contribute to regenerative cultures and take care of the planet."

OUR MISSION is based on four pillars that mutually support one another:

SUSTAINABILITY

To connect young people to ecovillages and sustainable initiatives where they can discover alternative low-impact lifestyles and find inspiration to align their personal choices with their values and the needs of the planet.

EMPOWERMENT

To empower young people to find their inner strength, take responsibility, take action, and embody the change they wish to see in the world.

LEARNING

To create opportunities for vouna people to grow personally and to explore sustainability in all its dimensions (social, worldviews and ecological, economical, cultural...) through transformative and experiential learning.

COMMUNITY BUILDING

To connect young people so that they can exchange practices and ideas, discover diverse experiences, feel part of an international and inclusive community and share a sense of belonging.









WHAT DO WE DO?

We weave an international network of individuals, organisations and venues involved in bringing young people close to ecovillages and other sustainable initiatives through Erasmus+ Youth projects. We support mainly 2 types of **European Youth projects within our network**: Youth Exchanges (YE) and Mobilities for Youth Workers.

Youth Exchanges (YE) are a type of learning mobility within the Erasmus+. They represent a common living for a short period of time where young people (18-30 y.o.) are implementing a non-formal learning programme (a mix of workshops, exercises, debates, role-plays, simulations, outdoor activities, etc.) on a topic of their interest.
